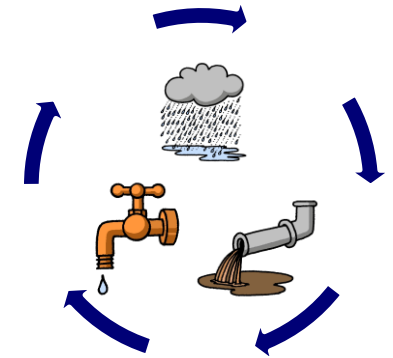

Achieving a truly sustainable urban water system is only possible when this system is designed, planned and managed in an integrated way.



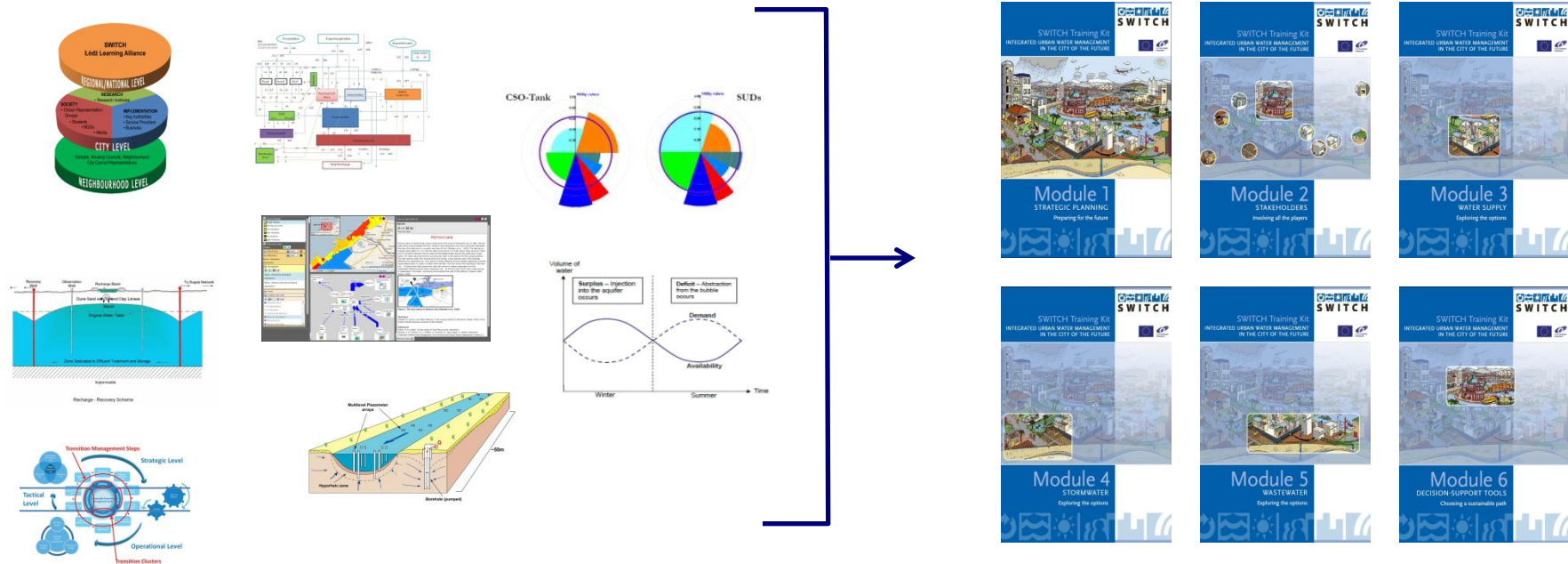
33 partners led by UNESCO-IHE
